CODE OF CONDUCT

This Code of Conduct identifies the standard of behavior which is expected of all members of the Northumberland Baseball Association (NBA). This policy is applicable to all players, guardians, managers and coaches, officials, volunteers, directors, officers, committee members, convenors, team managers, and administrators involved in NBA activities and events.

The NBA is committed to providing an environment in which all individuals are treated with respect. Members and Participants of the NBA shall conduct themselves at all times in a manner consistent with the values of the NBA, which includes fairness, integrity and mutual respect, and the promotion of fair play, sportsmanship, and player development.

Members and Participants of the NBA shall not engage in any activity or behavior which interferes with a competition, or with any player or team's preparation for a competition, or which endangers the safety and well being of others. At all times, NBA members and participants shall refrain from comments, or behaviors, which are disrespectful, offensive, abusive, racist or sexist.

The NBA only sanctions team events that are baseball related such as practices and games.

Specifically, during NBA activities and events, members shall avoid behavior which brings the NBA into disrepute, including but not limited to, the following:

- Excessive verbal abuse to Players, Parents, Managers & Coaches, and Game Officials.
- Threatening, or pushing, Players, Parents Managers & Coaches, and Game Officials.
- Consumption of Alcoholic beverages in the ballpark, before, during or after a game or practice.
- Disruption of game by causing arguments or altercations with other spectators, players, managers & coaches, or game officials.

Failure to comply with this code of conduct may result in disciplinary action in accordance with the Discipline Policy of the NBA. Such action may result in the member losing the privileges which come with Membership in the NBA, including the opportunity to participate in NBA activities and events, both present and future.
